

2017 Deluxe Pool Opening – Book Now!!

We will notify you if there are any changes to the date of your opening. Pool openings are Monday to Friday (excluding holidays). NO SATURDAY OR SUNDAY OPENINGS.

ALL BOOKINGS ARE ON A PRE-PAID FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS

Pool Opening Prices:

Pool Opening: Pump off water, remove and clean with Stow-Away (MSRP \$21.99), fold and store winter cover onsite; Clean waterline of winter debris; Complete 1 hour vacuum; Attach any ladders, lights, fittings, **etc.; Start up pool system*** **(if equipment is not in proper working order a service call must be booked to address the issue at a later date)**; Clean all equipment and surrounding area; Apply Deluxe Start Up Package (MSRP \$65) to pool water: Start Up shock, Start Up algaecide and Stain & Scale; Bag winter cover debris and put at curbside. The last thing we do is put the hose into the pool (if you do not want us to leave the water running, please advise when you book your appointment) **\$ 495***

Return Trip Included approx. 1 week later to perform water test, for balancing (optional). Chemicals are extra.

Spill-over Spa (spa attached to pool): Remove cover, clean spa & put hose into spa **\$ 115***

Hot Tub Opening: Clean cover and inside the tub; Fill tub to correct level; Turn on power to the tub; If you need chemicals please let us know in advance so we can bring them to you at the same time as the opening **\$ 150***

Extras:

Salt (50 pound/22 kilogram bag) \$ 14.95/bag*

***HST Extra.** Charges are within our primary zone and are for maximum allocation of 2 hours x 3 person crew. Extra time is charged at \$150/hour at the beginning of each additional hour.

Please Note: HOMEOWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TURNING OFF WATER WHEN THE POOL/SPA IS FILLED TO CORRECT LEVEL

Please turn on power for the pool pump and turn on water for hose

Leave your salt cell (if applicable), vacuum hose and vacuum head where it is easily accessible

Pools with safety covers please allow 10 days from opening for your water to clear

**Per guidelines from the Pool & Hot Tub Council of Canada and Industry Standards for Improved Safety, we legally cannot attach or remove diving boards from the pool due to safety issues.

*** Our pool technicians are not TSSA licensed gas fitters; therefore they are not legally allowed to turn on the gas to your heater or start the heater. Pool heaters should have an annual inspection from a TSSA licensed gas fitter. Please contact us if you would like us to refer you to one.
